- Club Officers
 - Vice President: John Cannonico
- Not For Profit Status: As officers have been finalized, we can now pay the fee and move on with the process, which Shadd will continue to help facilitate.
- Club Logo: Members voted and it was decided that the design including the ace will be adopted as our official disc logo. The logo does need to be in line art, ASAP, within a week, by 3/22/2009.
